The Zion Township Assessor's Office is scheduling appointments at this time to file Circuit Breakers. If you are a resident of the City of Zion that is age 65 or older, please call our office at (847) 872-5031 to schedule your appointment. Circuit Breakers will be filled out by appointment only.

When coming to your appointment you must bring the following information with you:

- Form SSA-1099, Social Security Benefit Statement for 2009
- Social Security letter showing new 2010 benefits
- Monthly income for 2010 – Total amount of bank accounts, investments, pension, and cash
- Income for 2009
 - Gross amount** of Social Security
 - Annuities
 - Veterans' Benefits
 - Interest and Dividends
 - Capital Gain (or Loss)
- Property tax paid in 2009 – or – Rent paid in 2009, including: name, address and phone # of landlord
- Medicare Card
- If applied for Medicare Part D, what is the name of the plan you were assigned?
- Bring your prescription card with you.
- If you have a life insurance policy with a total cash value greater than \$1,500 please know what that cash value is.

- Pensions
- Wages, Salaries
- Other Income
