BOARD SPECIFIC ISSUES

- > Decennial Committees on Local Government Efficiency Act.
- Zion Township submitted a grant to Illinois DCEO Energy Transition Community Grant for \$243,981 to support the Emergency and General Assistance Programs.
- > We are doing a review of our insurance policy, considering moving to Blue Cross Blue Shield, as Humana is moving away from Employer Medical Insurance.
