Eligible individuals must be at least 18 years old, live in northern Lake County and be uninsured or have Medicaid.

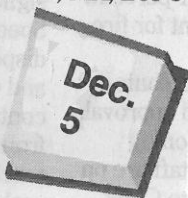
The office is open Mondays from 8 a.m.-4 p.m.
