Zion and Benton Townships are offering a new prescription discount program which allows all residents regardless of income, age, or health status to save on their cost of prescriptions.

This free card is offered through Coast2Coast Rx and is good for the entire family, including seniors.

It can also be used for pet prescriptions.

The card can be picked up at either Township office, or can be downloaded and printed by going to www.coast2coastrx.com under "townships."

This is another way to help ease the financial burdens local families are experiencing. This Rx card can have a sizable impact on uninsured residents for residents facing high deductibles.

There are no fees for either Township. The card has no expiration date, and there are over 59,000 plus pharmacies including major chains, and most independents participating.

Along with the discount on prescriptions, the card provides 50 to 80 percent discounts for lab and imaging tests, further helping residents to save money on their healthcare costs.
